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

Between grades two through four he fell behind peers in all language arts competencies. Matvey could not use textbooks in his regular class without one-to-one help, produced fragments and run-ons full of misspelled words when asked to write a paragraph, and had withdrawn from school to the extent of inventing illnesses so he could stay home.</p> <p>1. Now I think it was worth following her advice, but I did not find how.
